

2019 Summer Reading Program

Welcome to the 2019 Summer Reading Program! The South Georgia Regional Library offers programs for children (0-12), teens (13-18) and adults (18+).

How does it work?

Sign up and obtain logs at any of our branch library. Incentives and prizes are earned by reading the required number of books or hours.

Children

Once you have read 20 age-appropriate books or 20 chapters, write down the book titles/chapters and authors, then bring your log and incentive card back to the library to earn a prize.

Pre-readers participate by having others read to them. When older children read to young ones, they both get credit for the book.

Teens

Read six books to complete your log. Make sure to write down the titles and author for each book you read. Once you have completed six books, bring your log and incentive card to the library to earn a prize.

Adults

For every 30 minutes you read, fill in one oval on your log. Once you have filled up your log (25 hours read), bring your log and incentive card to the library to earn a prize.

Prize drawing

The Summer Reading Program prize drawings will be held at the Willis L. Miller Library located at 2906 Julia Drive in Valdosta on July 27th during the annual Summer Celebration from 2:00-4:00 pm.
